Transanal irrigation (TAI), also referred to as bowel irrigation, is a long-term solution for numerous pediatric patients and their families struggling with bowel dysfunction.

TAI facilitates the restoration of a healthy bowel routine and overall well-being through the use of lukewarm water. Moreover, it empowers children to regain authority over the timing and location of their bowel movements.

This empowerment translates into heightened self-assurance and an increased ability to allocate time for fun. Adolescents and older children can often acquire the skills to independently perform the procedure, fostering autonomy and self-esteem.

The establishment of a more predictable bowel-emptying routine instills caregivers with a sense of security and confidence, particularly when the child is away, either at school or with friends. In the home setting, TAI can save a lot of time and effort.





LOW VOLUME TAI

In some cases, low-volume transanal irrigation may be a more suitable option for your patient.

Low-volume systems, consist of a small reservoir attached to a cone that delivers less than 250ml of water.

The therapy is mainly used to start or complete defecation and clear the rectum. This can be beneficial in cases where help is needed to clear out last remaining bits of stool to prevent leakage or the uncomfortable sensation of incomplete emptying.





A small solution for instant results

Navina Mini is a discreet and intuitive low-volume irrigation solution that can help with symptoms such as incomplete emptying or soiling. With a gentle flush of water, it clears the lower part of the rectum, providing immediate relief easing symptoms like incomplete emptying and fecal incontinence/soiling.

The squeeze-friendly bulb holds 185ml of water and the cone has a rounded tip for comfortable insertion. Navina Mini also comes with an extension tube if extra reach is required. Can be used for children 3 years old and up.



Navina Irrigation System

Intended use

Navina Irrigation System is intended for Transanal Irrigation by instilling water up into the lower part of the colon through a rectal catheter.

Indications

The Navina Irrigation System is indicated to help adults and children from 3 years who suffer from fecal incontinence, chronic constipation, and/or time consuming bowel management. By instilling water up into the lower part of the colon, the peristaltic muscles in the bowel can be triggered and start to evacuate the content of the lower colon and rectum.

Contraindications

Do NOT use Navina Irrigation System if you have one or more of the following:

- Known anal or colorectal stenosis
- Active inflammatory bowel disease
- · Acute diverticulitis
- Colorectal cancer
- Ischemic colitis
- You are within three months of anal or colorectal surgery
- You are within 4 weeks of previous endoscopic polypectomy
